ORAL ORDER

2 03-03-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offences punishable under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the first information report in which the informant has given a very graphic account of the occurrence. However, subsequently in her further statement she has taken the name of the petitioner in a very vague manner and on instigation of somebody.

It is urged that in case the petitioner was involved in the occurrence there was no occasion for the informant in not naming him in the first information report. Petitioner has stated that his antecedent is clean.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, namely, Sahja Roy @ Sahjanand Roy is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sri Jyoti Prakash, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Patna in Phulwari Sharif (Janipur) P.S. Case No. 495/2013.
