Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 324, 326 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

It is alleged that co-accused Pintu Singh fired on the informant but did not cause injury to the informant but the fire of other co-accused Avinash caused injury on the left thy of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that accusation of firing is not specific against the petitioner and co-accused Kanhaiya Kumar has been granted anticipatory bail vide Criminal Miscellaneous No. 26250 of 2015. A statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lakhisarai in connection with Suryagarha P.S. Case No.67 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
