Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State.

This application for grant of anticipatory bail arises out of
Sirdalla P.S. case No. 208 of 2014, disclosing offences under
Sections 147,148,149,323,324,307,448,504,354,429,427 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
occurrence leading to the institution of the First Information

Report took place because of quarrel between the children of the informant and the accused for which case and counter case were filed. He submits that a petty dispute between the parties is the reason behind the institution of the First Information Report.

In view of the submissions as above, this application is accordingly, allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada in Sirdalla P.S. Case No. 208 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present themselves before the Police/Court, as the case may be, and when required and in the event of failure on their part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, their bail bonds shall liable to be cancelled.
