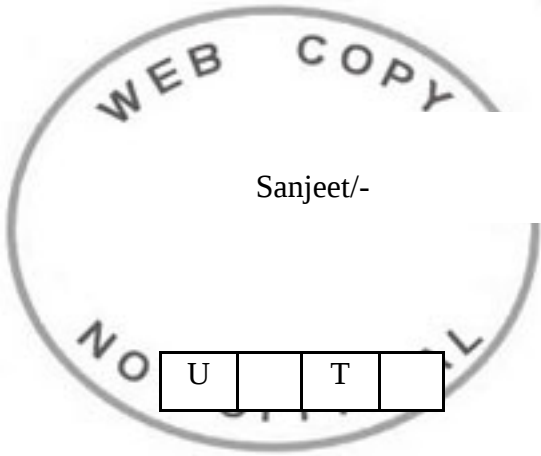
ORAL ORDER
