The Petitioners seek quashing of the order of non-discharge dated 16.05.2015 passed by the Sessions Judge, Katihar in S.Tr. No. 116 of 2015 arising out of Abadpur P.S. Case No. 45 of 2011.

Considering that the Petitioners seek quashing on disputed questions of fact which can not be gone into at the stage of Section 482 Cr.P.C., I am not inclined to interfere in the matter.

The application stands dismissed.

The Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same without granting unnecessary adjournment to any party and for which reason he is directed to send a list of the witnesses **fixing specific dates** for production of the witnesses along with a copy of this order, to the Superintendent of Police, Katihar, and the Superintendent of Police, Katihar is directed to ensure

production of the witnesses on the date so fixed by the Trial Court so that there is no further delay in trial.

However, the Trial Court shall ensure that the Forensic Report is received before the conclusion of the Trial.
