Petitioners are named in the first information report but according to the prosecution case itself, cash of the informant was snatched by unknown criminals. So far as petitioners are concerned, informant expressed his suspicion against them.

No doubt, in course of investigation, some cash was recovered from possession of the petitioner in Cr. Misc. no. 32420/2015 but there is nothing on record to show that recovered cash was looted property.

Moreover, both petitioners do not have any criminal antecedent and are languishing in jail custody since long.

Accordingly, petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Katihar in Azamnagar P.S. Case no. 75/2015.
