ORAL ORDER

2 04-12-2015 Interlocutory Application No. 9025 of 2015 has been filed for addition of relief by way of quashing the order contained in Memo No. 20/7 dated 31.10.2015 cancelling agreement of the petitioner No. 1 which has been passed subsequent to the filing of the writ petition.

2. Having regard to the nature of prayer, Interlocutory Application No. 9025 of 2015 is allowed.

After some arguments learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner Mr. Sunil Kumar seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file an appeal for redressal of his grievance against the impugned order dated 21.08.2015 passed against the petitioner no. 1 and to challenge any final order as may be passed in relation to petitioner no. 2.

4. Permission is accorded. The writ petition accordingly stands dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
