It has been further stated by the learned counsel for the parties that no selection for the post of Aanganwari Sevika and Sahaika at Aanganwari Centre No.160 Paraha-II in Karpi Block of Arwal District has been made so far after the order dated 26.09.2014.

In view of the aforesaid statement, the show
cause filed on behalf of the opposite parties is accepted.
