Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in connection with a
case registered for the offences punishable under Sections
419,420,468 and 417 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that thought there
was some discrepancy in the Madhyama certificate in pursuance
of which the petitioner was appointed as Aganwari Sevika, she
resigned on the same day after realizing the mistake. He further
submits that in view of the petitioner's resignation, no element of
criminality remains and, therefore, the First Information Report
instituted against her is wholly misconceived.

Considering the aforementioned submission and also
the fact that the petitioner has already resigned, let the petitioner

Amita Kumari, in the event of her arrest / surrender within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the each amount to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Gaya, in connection with Guraru P.S. Case No. 11/2015 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
