ORAL ORDER

This is an application, made under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking bail for the accused-petitioner, namely, Yogendra Yadav @ Murat Yadav @ Vanchar Yadav, in connection with Wazirganj Police Station Case No. 188 of 2014, under Section 147/148/149/341/323/384/435/427 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 16(i)(b)/17/20 of the Unlawful Assembly Act.

Perused the above application and materials on record.

Heard Mr. Kumar Dhirendra Pratap Singh, learned Counsel for the petitioner, and Mr. Yogendra Kumar Singh, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of the State.

In view of the fact that the accused above-named has been in custody in this case since 20.12.2014 in connection with the case aforementioned and similarly situated co-accused have been granted bail by a Bench of

this Court by the order, dated 19.01.2015, passed in Cr. Misc. No.32519 of 2014 and analogous cases, perusal of the materials available does not reveal such incriminating materials, which would warrant further detention of the accused-petitioner in custody, and in view also of the fact that the perusal of the materials does not reveal that the accused-petitioner's liberty on bail would adversely affect his trial, it is, in the interest of justice, hereby directed that the accused above-named shall be released on bail of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties, each of the like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya, in connection with Wazirganj Police Station Case No. 188 of 2014.

This direction for bail is further subject to the condition that the accused above-named shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence and shall appear, in the learned Court below, as may be directed.

In terms of the above observations and directions, this bail application shall stand disposed of.
