Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and
the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
29.01.2015 in a case registered for the offences punishable under
Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code.

On robbing of the motorcycle and one
thousand rupees of the informant the FIR was registered against
twenty unknown. The name of the petitioner sprang up on the
confession of co-accused Binod Yadav in another case.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that neither there is any recovery from the petitioner nor
the petitioner has been put on TIP. Statement to that effect has
been made in para 7 of the petition.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has not been put on TIP and the investigation has already concluded, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jamui in connection with Laxmipur P.S. Case No. 211 of 2014.

Since the petitioner has serious criminal antecedent, the learned court below will be at liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner in two eventualities i.e. if he defaults for two consecutive occasions or substantially gets involved in some serious nature of offence.
