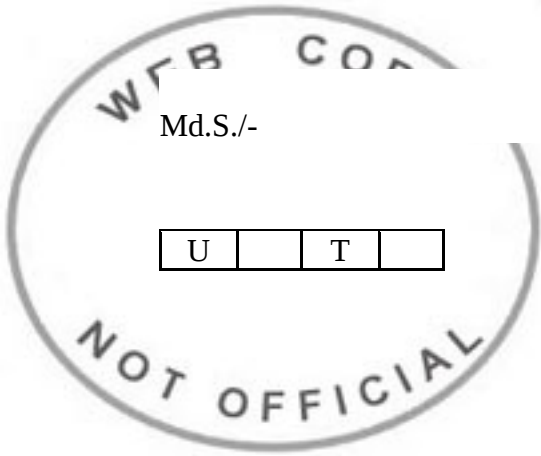
2 06-11-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection with
Jamhore P.S. Case No. 70 of 2015 registered under Section 414/34
of the Indian Penal Code as well as Sections 2(E), 3(8), 15 and 18
of the Mahua Flowers Act.

Regard being had to the violation of Rule 3 of the Bihar
Excise (Mahua Flowers) Rules, 2006 punishable under the Excise
