ORAL ORDER

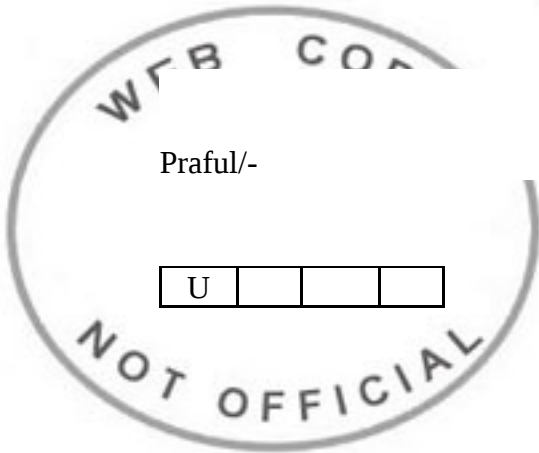
