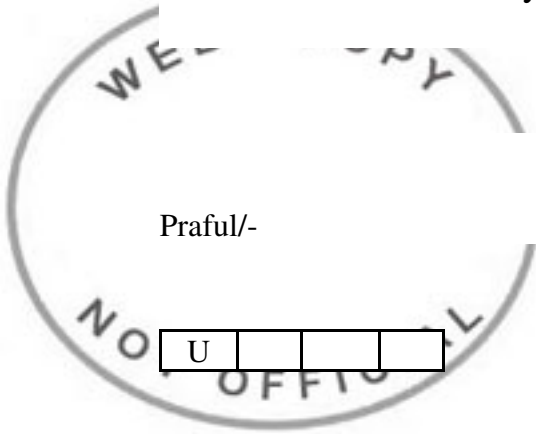
ORAL ORDER
