Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 3.8.2012 by which Additional Sessions Judge, Samastipur, has summoned the Petitioner to face trial under Section 319 Cr. P.C. in Sessions Trial No. 703 of 2009/327 of 2009.

Considering that the Petitioner was named in the First Information Report and, subsequently, named by the witnesses during trial, I see no reason for interference in the matter.

The application stands dismissed.

The Trial Court is directed to conclude the trial
