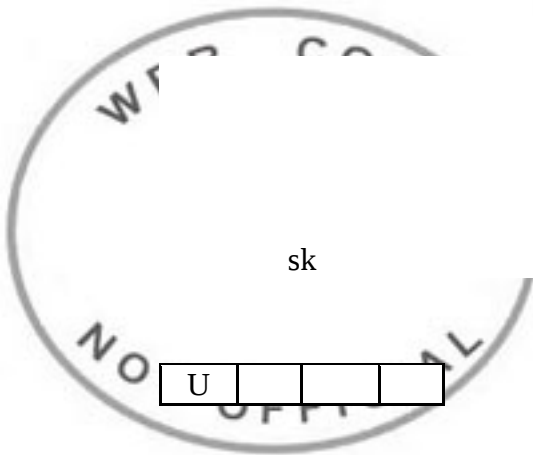
Heard learned counsel for the appellant as well as the State.
