After some argument, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to approach the respondent District Collector, West Champaran at Bettiah for restoration of RM 79 of 2000-01, which stood dismissed, not on merit rather for want of prosecution, vide order dated 03.05.2010 (Annexure-3).

Permission is accorded.

The writ petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

If an appropriate petition for restoration is filed on behalf of the petitioner within a period of 4 weeks from today with a certified copy of the present order and, if it is found to have

become barred by limitation and, if any petition is filed on behalf of the petitioner for condonation of such delay, then the respondent District Collector shall take into consideration that on a bonafide legal advice the present writ petition was filed on 30.10.2013 and that remained pending before this Court till date.
