Heard learned counsel, Mr. D. Bhattacharji for the petitioners and learned Additional Government Advocate, Mr. S. Chakraborty for the State-respondents as well as learned counsel, Mr. C. S. Sinha for the private-respondents.

It is submitted by learned counsel, Mr. Bhattacharji for the petitioners that the connected writ petition has been dismissed for non-prosecution on 04.07.2015 and he submits that he was busy in another Court and, therefore, he could not attend the Court when the case was called out.

Learned Addl. Govt. Advocate, Mr. Chakraborty and learned counsel, Mr. Sinha have no objection.

The prayer for restoration of W.P.(C) No. 466 of 2010 is allowed subject to payment of a cost of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees one thousand) to the Bar Council of Tripura.

If the cost is paid, the Registry is directed to restore the writ petition (W.P.(C) No. 466 of 2010) in its original form and list it for hearing.

The Interim Application accordingly stands disposed of.
