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Heard Mr. B. Majumder, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-applicant, Accountant General (A&E), Tripura as well as Mr. Samarjit Bhattacharji, learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner.

By this application filed under Order 1, Rule 10(2) of the CPC, the Accountant General (A&E), Tripura, the respondent No.8, has sought their deletion as they are in no way entangled in the dispute.

Mr. Bhattacharji, learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner has fairly acceded that the respondent No.8 is not a necessary party.

Having regard to that concession made by Mr. Bhattacharji, learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner as well as on scrutinising the pleading, this court is of the view that the respondent No.8 is not a necessary party in this dispute.

Accordingly, the name of the respondent No.8 stands deleted.

This application for striking out is therefore allowed and disposed of.
