2. Smt.Seeta Tiwari, wife of petitioner-Prabhat Tiwari of WP (S) No.524 of 2014 and original petitioner namely P.K.Shrivastava of WP(S) No.899 of 2014 had suffered from cancer and succumbed to death.
3. Additional return has been filed on behalf of the respondents/State on 12.10.2015 in WP(S) No.899 of 2014, in which it has been clearly stated that post-facto approval has been given for medical reimbursement amount incurred towards medical treatment and as such, these writ petitions have become infructuous.
