3. Shri Pali, learned counsel for the petitioner would apprehend that in the fresh selection process, the respondent No.1 will select the respondent No.3 by showing undue favour on the candidate.
4. Ordinarily, the recruitment process is governed under the terms of advertisement and the rules applicable for the subject recruitment. If any illegality is committed by the respondents, the petitioner would always be at liberty to approach this Court afresh.
5. With the above observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
