This writ petition has been preferred challenging the order passed by the Collector, Rajnandgaon on 09/12/2014 in appellate jurisdiction under Section 91 of the Chhattisgarh Panchayat Raj Adhiniyam, 1993. The said appeal was preferred by the petitioner challenging the order dated 01/05/2014 passed by the Chief Executive Officer, Janpad Panchayat, Khairagarh.

2. Admittedly the order impugned is revisable under the provision contained in Section 91 of the Adhiniyam, 1993 read with Rule 5 of

Chhattisgarh Appeal and Revision Rules, 1995. Thus, the petitioner has a statutory alternative remedy available to him.

3. In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction that in the event petitioner prefers revision application before the revisional authority within a period of one month, the said authority shall consider and decide the revision application on its own merits, after hearing all the parties concern within a period of six months.
