Learned counsel appearing for the State would submit that non-formal educational programme was directed to be closed/discontinued by the State Govt. vide order dated 22.04.2000 (Annexure R-2/1). He would also submit that Education Guarantee Scheme introduced in the year 2000 has also been abolished and the eligible Gurujies were

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	- 2 - considered and absorbed on the post of Shiksha Karmi. I have heard the counsel appearing for the parties and perused documents. The fact remains that non-formal educational programme under which the petitioners were engaged has already been abolished by the State Govt. vide order dated 22.04.2000 and subsequent scheme i.e. Education Guarantee Scheme has also been closed/discontinued, and as such, no relief can be granted to the petitioners, however, the petitioners are at liberty to file fresh representation before the respondent No.2&3, who in turn, shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law on its own merits. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands finally disposed of.
