On due consideration, the application is allowed. Delay in filing the CRMP is condoned. Heard on Cr.M.P. for leave to appeal followed by acquittal appeal under sub-section (3) of Section 378 of the Cr.P.C. against the judgment dated 4-8-2014 passed by the Special Judge (Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act), Bilaspur in Special NDPS Case No. 39 of 2013 whereby and whereunder learned court below acquitted the respondent for the charges of keeping 9 kg of Ganja with her. For the purpose of leave to appeal, perused the impugned judgment, evidence adduced before the trial Court and the charge sheet. On due consideration, in the opinion of this Court, it is a fit case for grant of leave to appeal. Consequently,
