JUDGMENT

(27.02.2015)

Per T.P.Sharma, J.:-

1. By this appeal under Section 374 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the appellant has challenged the legality and propriety of judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 13.12.2002 passed by the 6th Additional Sessions Judge, Raipur in Sessions Trial No.274/2001, whereby the trial Court has convicted the appellant under Section 302 of the IPC and sentenced imprisonment for life and fine of Rs.1000/-.
2. As per report dated 24.02.2015 of police station, Amanaka, district Raipur, the sole appellant- Ajmer Singh has died on 30.08.2013 during his treatment at Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Hospital, Raipur.
3. On account of death of sole appellant, the appeal abates and is dismissed as abated.
