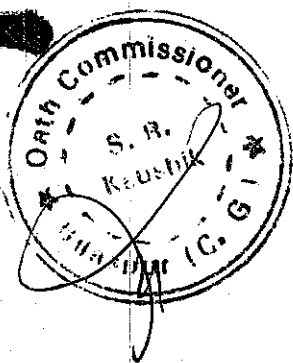

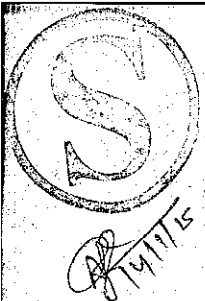

In view of availability of alternative remedy, the instant writ petition is not maintainable. The same is accordingly dismissed.
