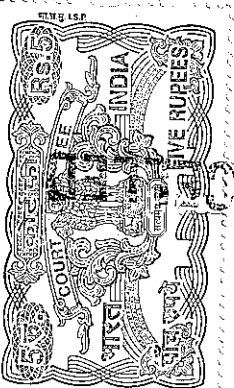

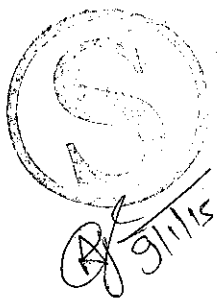

ORAL ORDER

The matter arises out of order passed by the Sub Divisional Officer (Revenue), Janjgir-Champa, whereby the diversion order has been cancelled.

2. Petitioner has alternative remedy of filing an appeal under the provisions of Chhattisgarh Land Revenue Code, 1959, therefore the present writ petition is not maintainable.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed with liberty to file a duly constituted appeal, in accordance with law, within a period of 30 days from today.
