Learned State counsel submits that the Station House Officer shall act in accordance with law laid down by the Supreme Court in the case of <u>Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh and others, 2008 (7) SCC 164.</u> In view of the above, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the Station House Officer, Gorella to act in accordance with law as per the directions of the Supreme Court in the case of Lalita Kumari (supra).
