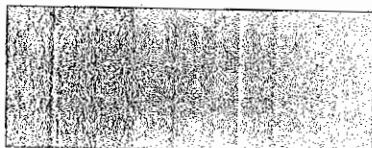
ORAL ORDER

(Passed on 11/03/2015)
