1. This is an application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the applicant, who has been arrested in connection with Crime No.48/2015 registered at Police Station-Pathhalgaon, Distt.Jashpur (CG), for offence punishable under Sections 307 & 376 of IPC.
