The accused/applicant has moved this bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for releasing him on regular bail during trial in connection with Crime No.364/2014 {ST No.62/2015 pending in the Court of Additional Sessions Judge (FTC), Bilaspur}, registered at Police Station Takhatpur, Distt. Bilaspur, for the offence punishable under Sections 306, 354, 454, 506B of the IPC, 7, 8 and 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.
