Hon'ble Shri Justice Sanjay K. Agrawal**Order on Board****17/08/2015**

1. This is the first bail application filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the applicant, who has been arrested in connection with Crime No. 163/2015, registered at Police Station City Kotwali, Dhamtari (C.G.), for the offence punishable under Section 420/34 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Case of the prosecution, in brief, is that present applicant and other co-accused Manjit @ Jasbir obtained Rs. 15,000/- from the complainant claiming to be an agents of Micro Finance Company promising grant of loan to them and thereby committed offence.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant would submit that applicant has not committed any offence and it is co-accused Manjit @ Jasbir who has obtained money and present applicant is only servant of main accused Manjit @ Jasbir. He would further submit that applicant is woman and pregnant. He would lastly submit that charge sheet has been filed and applicant is in jail

since 13/06/2015 therefore, she may be released on bail.

4. On the other hand, learned counsel for the State would oppose the bail application and submit that Rs. 2,000/- has been recovered from the possession of the present applicant.

5. I have heard learned counsel appearing for the parties and perused the case diary.

6. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case; further taking into consideration the nature and gravity of offence; role of the present applicant in offence in question; charge sheet has been filed; applicant is in jail since 13/06/2015 and applicant is woman and pregnant, this Court is of the opinion that present is the fit case, in which, the applicant should be enlarged on regular bail.

7. Accordingly, the bail application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. is allowed.

8. It is directed that applicant shall be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond in the sum of **Rs.25,000/-** with one surety in the like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court, for her appearance as and when directed.
