Budhiyaro Bai and convicted respondents No.1 Sheetal Singh and respondent No.2 Amar Singh as per para 26 of the judgment. For the purpose of hearing on leave to appeal, I have perused the impugned judgment, evidence and the documents annexed. In the considered view of this Court, this is a fit case where leave to appeal be granted. Consequently, the Cr.M.P. is allowed.
