Shri Agrawal has filed I.A. No.02, application seeking amendment in the writ petition. He submits that the petitioner has received many new documents after filing of the writ petition under the Right to Information Act and therefore these documents are necessary.

Opposing this amendment application counsel for the respondents have argued that mere filing of documents will not serve the purpose of the petitioner unless he makes specific pleadings and the respondents get liberty to counter the same.
