The instant Cr.M.P. followed by acquittal appeal has been preferred against judgment dated 24-06-2015 passed by the Special Judge under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short 'the NDPS Act'), Bemetara, C.G. in NDPS Case No.07/2014 whereby and whereunder the learned Court below acquitted the non-applicant/respondent from the offence under Section 20(b)(ii)(B) of the NDPS Act. For the purposes of leave to appeal, impugned judgment, documents and evidence adduced before the trial Court are perused.
