appointment expeditiously preferably within a period of two months from the day of receipt of copy of this order.

(4) It is made clear that neither this Court has expressed any opinion on the merit of the case nor has given any direction to appoint the petitioner on the said post.

(5) With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
