1. This is the second bail application filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the applicant who has been arrested in connection with Crime No.188/2014, registered at Police Station Pussore District Raigarh (C.G.), for the offence punishable under Section 394/34 of I.P.C.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant would submit that only three prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined.
