1. The petitioner is challenging the constitution of Gram Panchayat Navagaon, district Bemetara under Section 3 of the Chhattisgarh Panchayat Raj Adhiniyam, 1993.
2. Admittedly, the election process has commenced pursuant to the issuance of notification by the State Election Commission.
3. Any interference with the constitution of Gram Panchayat would have the effect of interfering with the election process, which is not permissible in law.
