	<u>S.B. HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE SANJAY K. AGRAWAL</u> <u>27.02.2015:</u> Shri Kalyan Kalanekar, learned counsel for the petitioner. Heard on admission. This contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner alleging that judgment and decree passed by the District Judge, Bilalod in Civil Appeal No 5A/2013 on 02.09.2014 giving certain direction to the Sub-Divisional Officer, Gunderdahi is not being complied with by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Gunderdahi. It is well settled that the decree passed by the Civil Court is executable in accordance with the provision contained in Order 21 of the Code of Civil Procedure and the contempt is not an appropriate remedy. Since the petitioner has alternatively remedy of getting the decree executed, the contempt petition as framed and filed is dismissed reserving liberty in favour of the petitioner to execute the decree in accordance with law. With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition is dismissed at the admission stage without notice to other side. No order as to costs.	Sd/- Sanjay K. Agrawal Judge
