In this petition, the petitioner, who is working as Upper Division Teacher in District Gariaband, is challenging his transfer from Government Higher Secondary School, Khadma, Development Block-Chhura, District Gariaband to Government Middle School, Gona, Development Block, Mainpur, District Gariaband, on administrative basis.

2. In view of the Clause 4 of the State Government's transfer policy dated 1-7-2015 for the year 2015-16, on the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to pursue the representation.
