1. I.A. No. 1 has been filed to condone delay of 10 days in filing review application. Considering the duration, delay is condoned.
2. The present review application arises from order dated 4.8.2015 in Writ Appeal No. 375 of 2015, the Special Leave Petition against which has also been dismissed on 11.9.2015.
3. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that dismissal of the Special Leave Petition in *limine* does not bar the maintainability of the review application.

4. While the simple proposition urged on behalf of Petitioner is not in dispute, the grounds urged in support of review application in paragraph 9 is that due to change in circumstances after passing of the judgment by this Court, some important facts and documents have come to light and which are required to be considered.

5. If the Petitioner was not vigilant in placing all relevant materials before the Court and seeks to become wiser by passage of time, that does not constitute sufficient ground as an error apparent on the face of record to maintain review application.

6. The review application is dismissed.
