No.01, which is an application for condonation of delay in filing the MCC. On due consideration, I am satisfied that the applicant succeeded in explaining the cause of delay in filing the MCC and, therefore, the application is allowed. Delay in filing the MCC is condoned. Counsel for the applicant is heard on restoration petition. The applicant is seeking restoration of Contempt Case (C) No.08/2014 which was dismissed for want of prosecution vide order dated 29.08.2014. On due consideration of the submissions of the learned counsel for the applicant and the grounds taken in the restoration petition, I am satisfied that the absence of the applicant's counsel on 29.08.2014, when Contempt Case (C) No.08/2014 was taken-up for hearing was based on <i>bonafide</i> grounds.
