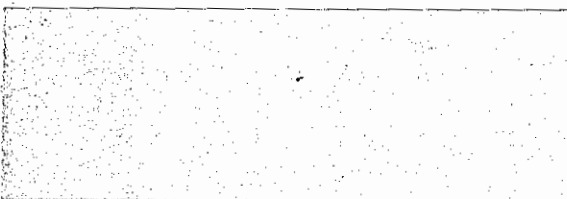

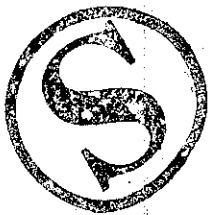

1. Grievance of the petitioner in the instant case is the arbitrary action on the part of the respondents in not granting promotion to the petitioner to the post of Lecturer (Sanskrit) in spite of the fact that his juniors have been promoted to the said post.
2. A perusal of the record would show that the petitioner has not made any representation to the respondents and has straightway rushed to the Court for redressal of his grievance. Therefore, this Court is of the opinion that it is a fit case where the writ petition can be disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to make a representation to the respondents.
3. Accordingly, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner shall make a representation before the respondents within a period of 7 days from today raising his grievance and in turn the respondents shall decide the case of the petitioner in accordance with law on its own merits within a further period of three months.





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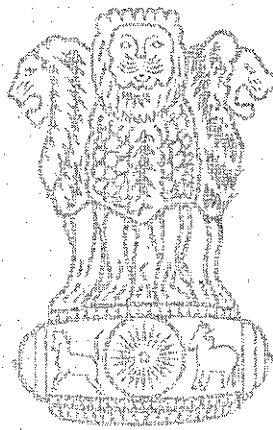
