- (2) In an application under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') for maintenance filed by applicant No.1/wife, applicant No.2/minor son and applicant No.3/minor daughter namely Smt. Dhaneshwari Sahu, Bhupendra Sahu and Ku.Monika Sahu, the Family Court, Mahasamund, by the

impugned order dated 01.05.2015 passed in Miscellaneous Criminal Case No.15/2015, rejected the application so far as it relates to applicant No.1/ wife Smt.
