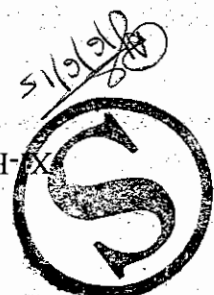

S.B.: HON'BLE SHRI JUSTICE PRITINKER DIWAKAR 15.06.2015 Shri B.P.Sharma, counsel for the petitioners. Shri Arun Sao, Dy. A.G. for the State. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the State government itself is considering to revise the market value fixed by it in relation to the property situate at Raipur for the current financial year. He submits that purpose of filing this petition would be served if the petitioners may be permitted to file representation before the Central Valuation Committee and in turn the Committee be directed to decide the said representation. State counsel submits that he is not aware of the fact that State government is in any manner considering for the revision of market value of the properties situate at Raipur. However he has no objection if the petitioner wants to make any such representation and the same is being decided by the Central Valuation Committee in accordance with law. The present petition is disposed of permitting the petitioners to file representation before the Central Valuation Committee. In case any such representation is filed the Committee may decide the same expeditiously strictly in accordance with law. It is made clear that this Court has not observed anything on merits of the case and the authority concerned would be at liberty to decide the representation strictly in accordance with law.
