**AWARD**

The contesting parties to this appeal have amicably settled the dispute voluntarily, which is subject matter of this appeal. We have also found that the terms and conditions of compromise/settlement arrived at between the contesting parties are just, proper and legal, therefore, the same are acceptable. We, accordingly accept the compromise/settlement, proposed by the parties and order that respondent No. 3- The National Insurance Company Limited shall pay to the appellant/claimant a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) by way of compensation, in addition to the awarded amount by the Tribunal, within 60 days from today, i.e. 12.12.2015, failing which the amount shall carry interest @ 6% per annum from the date of application till its actual payment.
