1. When the matter is called for hearing, none present for the applicants.

The accused/applicants have moved this bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for releasing them on regular bail during trial in connection with Crime No.271/2014 (Criminal Case No.11957/2014 pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Bilaspur), registered at Police Station Tarbahar, Bilaspur, Distt. Bilaspur, for the offence punishable under Sections 379, 420, 466, 467, 468, 470, 471, 403 and 411 read with Section 34 of the IPC.
