The instant Cr.M.P. followed by Acquittal Appeal preferred against the judgment dated 11.2.2015 passed in Criminal Case No. 999 of 2010 by the Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Durg whereby and whereunder the Respondents have been acquitted of the charges framed against them. Registry has pointed out the default. On due consideration, the default pointed out by the Registry is hereby overruled. For the purposes of Leave to Appeal, the copy of judgment, evidence of the witnesses and charge-sheet perused. The Cr.M.P. has been preferred after 96 days of its limitation. Issue notice to the Respondents through usual and registered mode, returnable within 4 weeks for their representation in the matter.
