O R D E R
(21.01.2015)

By way of the instant writ petition the petitioner has sought for a relief from the respondents for granting senior pay-scale w.e.f.1995 along with the benefit of selection grade as per the Career Advancement Scheme.

Counsel for the State submits that if the petitioner makes a fresh representation giving details of documents on the basis of which she is claiming the benefit, the concerned authority shall consider the case in accordance with law on its merit.

In the light of the submission made by the State counsel the instant writ petition is being disposed of at this juncture with a direction that the petitioner shall make a fresh representation to the respondents giving the details of documents on the basis of which she is claiming the benefits. The representation shall be made within a period of two weeks from today and on such representation being made, the State Government shall take an appropriate decision in accordance with law on its own merit within a period of three months from the date of receipt of representation. Needless to say that the State Government shall dispose of the representation by a speaking order.

With the aforesaid observation, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
