1. Heard.
2. The petitioners have filed this petition aggrieved on account of delay in culmination of conciliation proceedings.

The facts pleaded in the petition shows that in the matter of dispute between the Management and the petitioners, the matter has been referred to the respondent No.2 for conciliation proceedings under the provisions of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, the conciliation proceedings, however, remained pending without its logical conclusion one way or the other.
